What is a Cookie?

A cookie is a file that a user's computer downloads when accessing certain web pages to store and retrieve information about the browsing carried out from that computer. They have a dual function: to control for and recognise users, and gaining information about their browsing habits.

Types of cookies

Depending on the organisation managing the domain from which the cookies are sent and the data obtained, two types can be distinguished:

- Own cookies: those sent to the user's computer from a computer or domain managed by their issuer and from which the service requested by the user is provided.
- Third-party cookies: those sent to the user's computer from a computer or domain not managed by their issuer, but from another entity that processes the data obtained via the cookies.

If cookies are installed from a computer or domain managed by the issuer, but the information collected by them is managed by a third party, they are not considered as own cookies.

There is also a second classification according to the period of time cookies remain stored in the user's browser: these are session cookies or persistent cookies.

Finally, there is another classification with five types of cookies according to the purpose for which the data obtained is processed:

- Technical cookies allow the user to surf a web page, platform or application and use the various options or services existing therein, such as controlling traffic and data communication, identifying the session, accessing restricted access parts, remembering the elements comprising an order, carrying out the process of placing an order, making the application for register for or participate in an event, to use security features during navigation, to store contents for the broadcasting of videos or sound or to share content through social networks
- Customisation cookies allow the user to access the service with some features of a general nature pre-established according to a series of criteria on the user's computer terminal, such as the language, the type of browser through which the user accesses the service, and the regional configuration from which the service is accessed,.
- Analytical cookies: These track and analyse browsing behaviour on our website, to create user navigation profiles to introduce improvements in our services based on the analysis of the data usage. This provides the following information:
 - o The date and time of the last time the User visited our website.
 - o Access to the contents the Users chose in their last visit to our website.

This website may use the information from your visit to perform evaluations and statistical calculations on anonymous data, to guarantee the continuity of the service or make improvements to our Web sites. This information will not be used for any other purpose.

- Advertising cookies: These manage the advertising space on our website as efficiently as possible, based on criteria such as the edited content or the frequency with which advertisements are displayed.
- Behavioural advertising cookies: (also called tracking cookies) These help manage the advertising space on the website effectively. These cookies store information about users' behaviour obtained through continual observation of their browsing habits, which enables a specific profile to be prepared to display advertising accordingly.
- External social network cookies: Additional "plug-in" cookies exchange social content and can be used by third parties to track people, both members and non-members of a social network, to include behavioural advertising or for market research and analysis.

Cookies management

Notwithstanding the foregoing, Users can allow, block or remove cookies installed on their computer by configuring the browser options installed on it. However, by disabling cookies, some of the available services may no longer be operational. The way to disable cookies is different for each browser, but is usually done from the Tools or Options menu. You can also consult the browser Help menu where you can find instructions. Users may choose the cookies they want to work on this website at any time.
